1	GCC 18.2 : (Bid Security) the Bid Security shall be a demand guarantee, and in any of the following forms at the Bidder's option: an unconditional guarantee issued by a nationalized/ scheduled commercial bank located in India;	GCC 18.2 : Retained as per tender clause, Any Nationalised / scheduled commercial Banks with payable at Mumbai only
2	Experience of contractor (clause 2.1)	1. Bidder's Provisional Experience Certificate (Partial Work) should not be considered for meeting qualifying criteria. A. For Technical Requirement- For the purpose particular bid, bidder shall meet the following minimum criteria in past 7 years (up to last completed financial year)" i. Experience in similar work (as per clause 2.1.3 mentioned below) under single contract, costing not less than 70%. The works under the above contract should be completed works only. Or ii. Experience in similar works (as per clause 2.1.3 mentioned below) under two contracts, each costing not less than 40%. The works under the above two contracts should be completed works only. Or Experience in similar works (as per clause 2.1.3 mentioned below) under three contracts, each iii. costing not less than 309%. The works under the above three contracts should be completed works only. B. For financial Requirement- Considering the different point of views in respect of accepting the experience certificate, it is been decided to accept the experience certificate of the bidder who had completed the works during the period of previous seven 7 years i.e FY 2016-17 to FY 2022-23 irrespective of the date of LOA.
3	Adjustment of Mob.Advance (Appendix-1: TERMS AND PROCEDURES OF PAYMENT)	Interest on Mobilization advance shall be recovered from the date of Mobilization advance paid to agency to date of SAP technical invoice.
4	Rebate (Clause 12.5 Terms of Payment) The Employer shall be eligible for 1.50% of rebate of invoice value (excluding GST) in the event it makes payment to the Contractor within 10 days of receipt of invoices complete in all respect".	1. It is therefor clarified that 1. (i) If received invoice is complete in all respect (along with documents mentioned in SBD) in that case date certified by the SE infra office shall be considered for calculation of rebate. (ii) If received invoice is not in order as per point not 1(i) above at audit section; a) If the delay/incompleteness is attributable to agency then date of final compliance by technical section will be considered for rebate (sap compliance date shall be considered after b) In case the delay is attributable on the part of MSEDCL then dates for rebate shall be as per point no (i) above
5	JV Experience (2. Qualification Requirements)	1.In case of JV , MSME certificate of lead partner will be considered 2. In case bidder submitted JV Experience for Technical QR then following clarification shall be referred- a. Confirmation letter about experience may be taken from utility about their share of experience in addition to the undertaking from all joint venture members confirming the share of pure technical experience. The above certificate cum confirmation may please be taken before opening of price bid on Rs.100 Stamp Paper. If bidder fails to submit the above document, his offer is not considered for further evaluation. b. Further to avoid legal complication if bidder is participated in RDSS tender process and found L-1, the bidder jointly must give notarised confirmation and undertaking about technical experience in proposed project before issue of LOA. Above contents required to be mentioned by bidder in affidavit that "If Confirmation given is found be incorrect then they are liable for prosecution and cancellation of tender also blacklisting. This undertaking must be their in Affidavit (On Stamp Paper)
6	Insurance(Appendix-3 : INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS)	In addition to existing Clause in tender document, Insurance should be submitted as per Latest GR and latest directives issued by Govt of Maharashtra, and Directorate of Insurance along with endorsement in favour of MSEDCL.
7	MSME Certificate (ITB 10.2.8)	MSME status of Contractors for each further financial year shall be submitted at earliest after end of current financial year. In case of JV Partner, Lead Partner shall submit MSME Certificate.
8	Submission of Power of Attorney (Form 4)	Bidders should submit the POA as per SBD only. If bidder has submitted General POA, we may ask to submit POA as per Form 4 only.
